

### **CELEBRATING BIRTHDAYS**

#### THE FIRST-EVER BIRTHDAY PARTY

One of the elements of the Team Tesfa Sponsorship Program is to help every one of the 93 children feel celebrated, special and valued.

As a part of the annual budget, there is money to spend on a monthly birthday party for all of the children who have had a birthday that month. Tesfa purchases cakes, special candies, fruits and a small gift for each child.

One of the ways Ethiopians bring cheer to a birthday party is a spray that looks like snow. The sparklers on the cakes look like fireworks.



You can see in the pictures that the shelter is decorated, the birthday children are wearing their best clothing and each child is made to feel very special.

Tesfa said one of the girls was in tears because she had never been celebrated before. We believe that most of the children have never, ever had a birthday party.





Here in Canada, we know celebrating the birth of someone you love helps to encourage them, build their self-esteem and let them know they are cared about and valued. We are thrilled to know the children at Tesfa's Shelter - your sponsored children - will experience this joy.

#### TEAM TESFA AWARDS

The Team Tesfa Awards will be held once a year. For the first Team Tesfa Awards ceremony, Shelley was in Ethiopia and brought certificates for all the winners. Funds to purchase special foods and drinks for the Team Tesfa Awards are included in the shelter budget.

#### TEAM TESFA AWARDS

The awards recognize many different skills and characteristics. In many cases, there are multiple age groups for each category:

- Best Behaviour
- Best Effort in School
- Best Hard Work
- Creative Award (art, writing, poetry)
- Most Compassionate
- Top Academic Achievement
- Top Male Athlete
- Top Female Athlete



A volunteerism award will be given at the next Team Tesfa Awards as the children needed this concept to be introduced to them.



### AWARDS AT SCHOOL

Tesfa has a serious focus on education for the children.

They are diligent in their studies and are expected to spend dedicated and disciplined time studying every day.

One of the schools the children attend had a ceremony celebrating the top ranking students of each class.

Several children from Tefsa's Shelter were recognized for their academic achievements.



#### SCHOOL AWARD WINNERS

Children who received school awards for ranking in the top of their classes:

- Yabsira ranked 2nd in Grade 1 with a 97.8% average
- Siham ranked 2nd in Grade 3
- Eyob ranked 2nd in Grade 4
- Ashenafi ranked 1st in Grade 4
- Israel ranked 1st in Grade 5
- Alemayew ranked 1st in Grade 6
- Kirubel ranked 2nd in Grade 6
- Yosef ranked 3rd in Grade 6
- Kidus ranked 3rd in Grade 7
- Aysha ranked 2nd in Grade 7
- Sudi ranked 1st in Grade 7



### TESFA RECOGNIZED

Tesfa was awarded special recognition by the Ministry of Women and Children for taking 100 children from the streets and reuniting them with their families.



Tesfa connected with the families to ensure they were able to provide for their child(ren). They have now returned to school. This incredible man never stops responding to the needs in his community ... amazing!



## A NEW ADVENTURE

#### LUNCH AT A HOTEL RESTAURANT

Tesfa works with local businesses to seek support for clothing, haircuts, school supplies or other donations to cover as many of the shelter needs as possible. Before COVID-19 and the escalation of political and tribal tension, Tesfa was operating the shelter strictly with local support, though it was not always sufficient to cover all the children's needs.

Even before the pandemic, political instability had reduced local support to the point where Tesfa was unable to pay rent and the older children were not eating three times a day. Mothers with a Heart for Ethiopia has now been providing all the financial support needed to care for the children for over three years.



One local hotel promised to provide a nice lunch to all the children once a year. The children went to dine at a nice place with plenty of food. What a great experience to eat at a restaurant and be exposed to such a pleasure. A special day for all!

### **VOLUNTEERING TAKES HOLD**




When our Sponsorship Committee developed the Team Tesfa Sponsorship Program, we held as the highest priority that no child would feel less than another child.

We recognized two things:

- 1. It would take some time to have all 93 children sponsored.
- 2. Many sponsors would not be comfortable writing their sponsored child.

Friends Ink is a group of five volunteers who love to write and take turns writing the whole group of children once a month. Our volunteers in Friends Ink are loving this role and the connections we are making with the children on behalf of all our sponsors.
